

RADIO STATION MEMBERSHIP DUES

Please note: Every station sharing a common owner, operator, or licensee is required to pay dues.

Membership dues are calculated by each station's gross revenues (see scale below).

Dues caps are provided for multiple radio stations in the same market size (see cap chart below).

The CBA's fiscal year starts on July 1st and ends on June 30th. By completing and submitting an application, you commit to one year of membership for ALL owned/managed stations.
